



Corno Nero and Ludvigshohe are two nice small peaks in the Monte Rosa range. Thanks to their proximity, and their short access from the Lys Glacier, they are easy to combine in a day tour.

Program:

1st day: Meeting with the guide in Staffal around 7:00a.m. - Equipment check. We will take the cable car up to Punta Indren. From there we start to hike up in direction of the Gnifetti hut. Close to the hut, we put crampons and rope and we start to walk along the Lys Glacier. We arrive at the Colle Zurbriggen between the two summits and we take a longer break. We climb first the Ludwigshoehe along a fairly steep slope and its summit snow ridge. Back to the Col we climb the Corno Nero along the steep slope just above us; normally very good footprints are present. The descent follow the same itinerary.

You have to know:

Accommodation: No accommodation is required; this is a day tour

Meeting point: At 7:00am in our office in Staffal (Hotel Nordend near to the bar da Giovanni)..

Requirements: the only technical difficulty is the steep slopes (up to 50°) going on top of Corno Nero, but thanks to the footprints normally present on the slope and the help of the guide, can be easily tackled by any good and fit hiker.

Equipment: See the equipment list below.

Weather: In the high mountains, even in summer, there could be extreme weather conditions. Three/four days before the tour/trip, we will check the weather forecast in the area, and we will inform you about it!

Leading Guide: Mountain Guide or Aspirant of Guidemonterosa. Shortly before the tour, you will get the phone number of the guide. For all other questions, please contact our office.

Helpful for preparation:

Apparel / Clothing:	We recommend functional clothing / layering principle so you can react to the different temperatures.
Boots:	Waterproof mountaineering/trekking boots suitable for crampons.
Lunch:	Please take some snacks and drinks with you.
Back pack:	As this is a day tour you don't need to carry too many things. Take with you just an extra layer in case of cold and a shell if it is windy; plus some snacks to eat and some energy drinking. At the end you have to carry your back pack. We recommend a back pack with 30L.
