



The top ridge the travers of Breithorn counts 5 different peaks over 4000 meters. The whole traverse of this ridge can be easily considered one of the nicest climbing among the many of the Monte Rosa. Thanks to the variety of the terrain and the quality of the climbing, it can satisfy even the most experienced mountaineer.

Program:

- 1st day:** Meeting with the mountain guide in Cervinia at 14:00. After checking your equipment, you ascend by cable car to Plateau Rosa. Overnight stay at the Cervino Guide Refuge, located at the arrival point of the Plateau Rosa cable car.
- 2nd day:** Departure around 5:00 depending on the period of the year. We easily walk to the base of the Roccia Nera where the Rossi e Volante bivouac is. From here, we climb the steep slope until the top of the Roccia Nera, our first summit of the day. Here the proper Breithorn ridge starts; along this traverse, we cross the summits of Breithorn twin (4106 m), Breithorn East (4141 m), Breithorn Central (4160 m) and finally the Breithorn West (4165 m). During the traverse, we enjoy some snow ridges, few abseiling and good rock climbing. From the summit of Breithorn West, we follow the easy and busy regular route back to Plateau Rosa .

You have to know:

- Accommodation:** Rifugio Guide del Cervino (3450 m)
- Meeting point:** At 14:00 pm at the lift station in Cervinia.
- Requirements:** Steep terrain, exposed snow ridges, rock climbing up to grade III° and confidence with abseiling technique. You should have already made similar tours.
- Equipment:** See the equipment list below.
- Weather:** In the high mountains, even in summer, there could be extreme weather conditions. Three/four days before the tour/trip, we will check the weather forecast in the area, and we will inform you about it!
- Leading Guide:** Mountain Guide of Guidemonterosa. Shortly before the tour, you will get the phone number of the guide. For all other questions please contact our office.

Services included:

- Mountain Guide IFMGA for 2 days
- Overnight in Rifugio Guide del Cervino (3450 m) in halfboard
- Cable car Ticket Cervinia-Plateau Rosa
- Equipment: Harness, crampons ice axe/sticks,

Helpful for preparation:

Apparel / Clothing: We recommend functional clothing / layering principle so you can react to the different temperatures.

Boots: Mountaineering boots for crampons.

Lunch: Snacks and drinks you can buy in the hut. Please take some snacks and drinks with you.

Back pack: Do not put too many things! You will be amazed how few things you need. Functional clothing for the day and a change shirt for the hut is usually enough. At the end you have to carry your back pack. We recommend a back pack with 30-40L.
